1. Offer your intentions.
Make the sign of the cross and kiss the crucifix.
Say the "Apostles Creed"
2. Pray the "Our Father"
3. Pray 3 "Hail Mary's" for Faith, Hope, and Charity
4. Pray the "Gloria Be"
5. State the 1st Mystery and pray "Our Father"
6. Pray 10 "Hail Mary's" while contemplating the Mystery
7. State the next Mystery and pray the "Our Father"
8. State the next Mystery and pray the "Our Father"
9. Repeat step 6
10. Pray "Hail Holy Queen" and "Final Prayer"
11. Make the sign of the cross and kiss the crucifix

Joyful Mysteries (Mon; Thu; Sun of Advent, Christmaside & Time After Epiphany)
Annunciation: Lk 1- Far not, Mary, for thou hast found grace with God.
Visitation: Lk 1- My soul doth magnify the Lord. And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior
Nativity: Lk 2- Glory to God in the highest; and on earth peace to men of good will.
Presentation: Lk 2- Behold this child is set for the fall, and for the resurrection of many.
Finding Jesus in the Temple: Lk 2- Did you not know, that I must be about my fathers' business?

Sorrowful Mysteries (Tue; Fri; all the days of Septuagesima & Lent)
Agony in the Garden: Mk 14- Abba, Father, all things are possible to thee: remove this chalice from me; but not what I will, but what thou wilt.
The Scourging: Jn 18- Every one that is of the truth, heareth my voice. Pilate: What is truth?
Crowning with Thorns: Mt 27- And bowing the knee before him, they mocked him
Carrying of the Cross: Jn 19- And bearing his own cross, he went forth to Calvary
Crucifixion: Lk 23- Armen I say to thee, this day thou shalt be with me in paradise

Glorious Mysteries (Wed; Sat; Sun of Easteride & Time After Pentecost)
Resurrection: Mt 28- Jesus who was crucified. He is not here, for he is risen, as he said.
Ascension: Mt 28- Teach ye all nations; baptizing in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost.
Pentecost: Acts 2- Jesus delivered up himself, for the love of us, and for the sake of our salvation
Assumption: Rv 12- As I have received of my Father: and I will give him the morning star, and on her head a crown of twelve stars

Symbolum Apostolorum (Apostles Creed)
Credo in Deum Patrem omnipotentem, Creatorem caeli et terrae. Gloria (Glory Be)

Oratio Fatimae (Fatima Prayer)

Salve Regina (Hail Holy Queen)
